[Low Water Crossings](#) (bad link, looking for another one) These are City of Austin problem points where streets are subject to flooding due to creeks or drainage. They have railroad style crossing arms to keep motorists out of the water risk. The map is in several sections covering different areas of the city.

[School Locations](#) . These Major AISD and RRISD schools and public facilities have been used as either shelters or staging areas. See the Web Links page under Mapping Resources for additional detail on schools and street addresses.
